

EXMOUTH TOWN GOLF SOCIETY

Minutes of the A G M held on Saturday 2nd March 2002
At Mayfield Lodge, Roserrow Golf and Country Club. St Minver, Cornwall.

Mark Reynolds opened the meeting at approx 10-15pm.

Members present. Paul Marshal, Graham Clarkson, Alan House, Keith Williams, Nick Parrish, Paul Kelly, Stuart Coleman Wayne Taylor, Graham Taylor, David Reynolds, Mark Reynolds, Darren Fricker, Phil Beynon, Peter Bonetta, Andy Bonetta.

- 1) Minutes for the previous AGM were not available and therefore could not be agreed.
- 2) Phil Beynon was proposed to act as Captain for the coming year, which was agreed by all present and accepted by Phil.
- 3) The Captain asked Mark Reynolds to continue to Chair the meeting, as there was no other officer of the club in attendance.
- 4) Paul Kelly was proposed as Vice Captain, which was also agreed and accepted.
- 5) The position of Treasurer was discussed, and although not present at the meeting the members were informed that Roy Mitchel had indicated his interest in the position, it was unanimously agreed to accept Roy's offer for the post.
- 6) It was proposed that the name of the Society should be changed from "Exmouth Town Football Club Golf Society" to "Exmouth Town Golf Society" as there is now no connection with the football club. All present agreed, and the Vice Captain offered to produce an official Letter Heading to be used for all Society correspondence.
- 7) The annual £5 membership was discussed and it was agreed that this should continue for at least the current year.
- 8) A general discussion was then held on the handicap system. It was finally agreed that a sub committee should be formed to formulate a system that would be in operation before the next meeting, which is at Dainton Park on Wednesday 20th March 2002. The committee would consist of the Captain, Vice Captain and Alan House.

- 9) It was then suggested by David Reynolds that the Club needed a better structure and proposed Paul Marshall as chairman; the proposal was accepted and agreed by all present.
- 10) Peter Bonetta offered to draw up a Club Constitution for submission to the Members.
- 11) Wayne discussed the options for the end of Season weekend and proposed that it should be held on 13th 14th 15th September 2002 at Trethorne Golf Club, Launceston. The cost would be approx £151 inc of Prizes and he would have details finalised within a week if the members agreed it. Wayne was thanked for his hard work and asked to make the necessary booking with Trethorne.
- 12) Phil Beynon offered to purchase a Trophy sponsored by Garage Doors and Gates, Exmouth, for a match play competition to be at a date to be arranged this year.
- 13) Mark Reynolds informed the members present that the venues for the season had been arranged and a fixture list would be sent out with the AGM minutes. It was proposed that each event would be £20 inc of 2's and prizes, this would balance out throughout the year when playing at courses that are more expensive.
- 14) Any other business
Alan House suggested a team shirt or sweater and would look at the possibility of obtaining some form of sponsorship.
Mark and Wayne indicated they might wish to step down at the end of the year in order to give other members the opportunity to become involved with the social organisation of the weekends and fixtures for 2003.
