1. **Paul Marshall (Chairman) opened meeting at 7.40.**

3. **Minutes of previous AGM** read and agreed. Proposed by Nic Paris seconded by Phil Beynon

Chairman's Report---- presented by Paul Marshall
Paul was happy to report that there had been a good turn out at meetings and that everything had appeared to run well with a big thank you to Mark Reynolds for arranging the fixtures. It was agreed that a new Bank account should be opened for the Society and that the new Treasurer would look into this and deal with accordingly.
Handicap Secretary's Report---presented by Phil Beynon.
Phil was able to report that the proposed changes to the system had worked well and appeared to be much fairer. Monthly meetings had taken place to iron out any problems and this saw a reduced number incorrect cards being returned. There had been several different winners and in the coming year there would be a slight change where handicaps can go up as well as down.
Secretary's Report --- Mark Reynolds was able to report that he would arrange similar fixtures to the previous season starting at Lyme Regis. Some discussion took place regarding the cost to be applied for each meeting, there was a preference for the same fee to be charged irrespective of the venue. PM proposed and seconded by Mel Brash that we apply an amount of £25 including two's but it was agreed that Mark would refer back to an appropriate Committee Meeting for approval once the individual green fees were known.
